*INFORMATION CLAUSE ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING*  
(where personal data have not been obtained from the data subject)

Pursuant to article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR) we would like to inform you that:

1. The Controller of your personal data is Wrocław Medical University with its registered office at Wybrzeże Pasteura 1, 50-367 Wrocław, hereinafter referred to as the "Controller", represented by the Rector;
2. The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer whom you can contact at the following email address: [iod@umed.wroc.pl](mailto:iod@umed.wroc.pl) in relation to all issues associated with the processing of personal data.
3. Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
  - a) admission to study as part of the recruitment process, and in case your candidature is accepted, for the purpose of the conclusion of a contract, as well as for the purposes resulting from the process of study, including the issuance of a student's ID, granting financial aid benefits, allocating room in the University's dormitory,
  - b) performance of statistical and reporting obligations of the Controller;
  - c) service marketing, in relation to the services provided by the Controller,
  - d) archiving.
4. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is:
  - a) Art. 6 sec. 1 (a) of the GDPR, i.e. Your consent to carry out the recruitment process and for the purposes provided in point 3 (c),
  - b) Art. 6 sec. 1 (b) of the GDPR, i.e. the contract concluded between you and the University,
  - c) Art. 6 sec. 1 (c) of the GDPR, i.e. carrying out the legal obligations of the Controller with regard the law provisions on higher education and other provisions to which the Controller is subject, including accounting, reporting, statistical and archiving obligations;
5. Your personal data may be made available by the Controller to its internal organisational units, entities providing it with system service and maintenance services, as well as recruitment intermediaries and other bodies or entities authorised under separate regulations;
6. The Controller may entrust the processing of your personal data on behalf of the Controller to another entity by a written agreement;
7. The Controller will store your personal data for the period necessary for processing purposes, nevertheless not less than the period set forth in the provisions on archiving. Where processing is based on consent, the Controller will store your personal data not longer than until the withdrawal of the consent;
8. In the events, under the terms and in the manner specified in the effective regulations, you have the right to demand that you are given access to the content of your data and that you have your data rectified (Art. 15 and 16 GDPR), erased (Art. 17 GDPR), that the processing of your data is restricted (art. 18 of the GDPR), object to the processing of personal data (Art. 21 GDPR), or to the transfer of your data (art. 20 GDPR) and withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the data processing which was carried out on the basis of the consent prior to the withdrawal thereof);
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office - if it is suspected that the processing of personal data by the Controller infringes the provisions of law;
10. The provision of your personal data is not obligatory, nevertheless it is indispensable in order to realise the purposes for which the data was collected. Failure to provide the data will result in refusal to be qualified for the recruitment process or refusal to conclude a contract.  
In a case your candidature is accepted, the obligation to provide your personal data results from the provisions on higher education;
11. Your personal data are not subject to automated individual decision-making, including profiling, referred to in Art. 4 point 4) GDPR, which is a form of automated processing of personal data consisting in using personal data to evaluate certain personal aspects of an individual;
12. Your personal data may be transferred to third countries (i.e. countries outside the European Union) or international organisations under the relevant legal provisions.
